

**26th FESTIVAL OF INDIA & PARADE**  
**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR RENTING FOOD BOOTH (S)**  
**Saturday, August 18 & Sunday, August 19, 2018 (10:00 am – 7:00 pm)**

**1. Arrival and Setting Up Time**

You must arrive at the Mela (Fair) site on Saturday, the August 18 and 19, 2018 no later than 7:30 am and set up your booth by 9:30 a.m. Because of the liability and the safety issues, no vendor vehicle (s) will be allowed to enter the Mela site after the set up times mentioned above. After unloading the contents of your vehicle (s), you must park your vehicle (s) at the outside the festival area. *All food vendors must enter from the Walnut Avenue entrance. All food vendors have to attend the City of Fremont / Alameda County Health Department sponsored class about food booth health requirements.* At the end of the Mela on Saturday, you should remove all of your valuable contents in the booth and bring them back again the next day on Sunday for display/sale. Even though the Federation of Indo Americans of Northern California (FIA) will have security at the site, it will not be responsible for any loss or theft of any property if left unattended overnight at the site.

**2. Permit from Alameda County Department of Environment Health**

You must secure permit from the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health prior to setting up a food booth at the festival and abide by their rules and regulations and the requirements of the Fire Department of City of Fremont. Non-compliance with these conditions will result in shutting down of your booth and no refund of your deposit will be given.

**3. Cleaning Deposit**

- A refundable cleaning deposit in the amount of \$100 is required as a surety towards leaving your booth area clean at the end of the Mela. The amount of refund will depend upon the cleanliness of the booth at the end of the Mela. The refund check will be sent latest by the end of September.

**4. Prohibition from playing Music**

- You agree that no loud music or sound will be played from your booth as this disrupts other booths as well as the cultural program on the stage.
- If you are found playing music and or any other instrument at any time regardless of sound level, you will be asked to vacate the booth and barred from renting a booth at future festivals. In addition, your deposit of \$100 along with applicable booth charges will be forfeited.

**5. Non-Profit Organizations**

- If you are a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, currently registered in the State of California (A copy of the current registration must be furnished at the time of booking a booth.
- By renting a booth at this festival you agree to automatically become a member of the Federation of the Indo Americans of Northern California (FIA).

**6. Confirmation of your booth**

- The allocation of booth and booth number will be final only after your payment is confirmed by FIA.
- The cancelled check/payment receipt (electronic) is your proof of payment.

**7. Vacation of Booths on Saturday, August 18 and Sunday, August 19, 2018**

- The booths activity will be allowed only up to 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 18, and Sunday, August 19, 2018.

**8. Miscellaneous**

- Please do not dispose glass pieces at the site and make sure that a proper system is followed to dispose of oil, charcoal and other hazardous waste. No disposing into storm drains on site. Please bring 50' extension cord as the nearest power plug may be at that distance.
- Please make sure that no nails or pointy objects are left behind on site in your booth area.
- No glass bottles will be allowed on site (food vendors can pour drinks into cups)
- Please pick up any metal that is left and also you may be required to power wash (or pay from your security deposit) as needed especially where there are food spills, toilet spills, and drink spills.
- Please do not use or spray materials or make any kind markings on the pavement. Do not use materials or sprays that may damage the parking lot surface.
- Styrofoam is banned in Fremont effective this year. Styrofoam products are not allowed under any circumstances in the Festival mela (fair) Ground.
- All food booth vendors will have to attend a mandatory health meeting with the City /County health department.
